**“Stepping ON” classes coming to Brainard!** This class is FREE (through grant funding) for anyone 60 years of age and older. Classes will be held for seven weeks, on Thursday afternoons at the Klein Center from 1:00 – 3:00 pm, starting on June 2<sup>nd</sup>. “Stepping ON” is an evidence-based fall prevention class for older adults. This program is designed for people who are living at home and want to remain independent in their own homes. It is effective in reducing falls by more than 30%. The program incorporates strategies to implement positive lifestyle changes to keep you independent, upright, and active.
