New Fund: Our parish recently opened a new account with the Catholic Foundation of Southern Nebraska. The Catholic Foundation, a separate entity from the diocese, has managed our endowment fund for the past 20 years, and has done so very successfully. This new fund will be invested in the market the same way the endowment is. However, our new account will be 100% liquid. As pastor, I intend to treat the account as a sort of savings account that gets a higher rate of return. Of course, the market is volatile, but even modest returns over time would be significantly greater than the interest gained by our current accounts with the diocese. Opening this account is part of my attempt to ensure that, despite increasing costs and decreasing population, our parish is able to thrive for many years to come.
